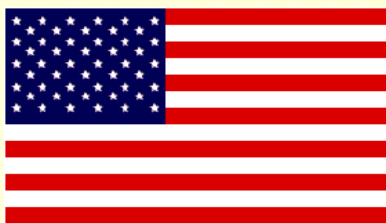

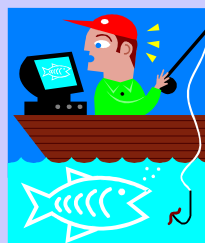

Parish picnic 9/8. Need volunteers to cover the Knight Info table on Sunday after the Masses.



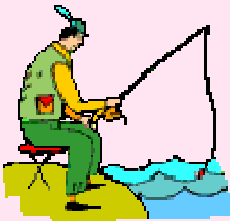
The “Hunting for Vocations” will be 12/7-9. Need 1 to 12 hunters. Deposit of \$100 at October meeting.
